Camp Ignite is officially open, and we can't wait to see your students there!

Please remember—all forms must be submitted in the presence of an advisor.

Here's what you need to know:

- **Registration Deadline:** May 7
- **Camp Dates:** June 2–4
- **Check-In:** Begins at 1:00 PM on June 2
- **Dismissal:** Between 2:00–2:30 PM on June 4
- **Cost:** \$250 (includes lodging, meals, and all programming...what a bargain!!)

The HOSA Store will also be open during camp with camp shirts and other HOSA items available for purchase.

Camp Ignite is truly *HOSA in action*- a place where students step into leadership, build confidence, and experience something that sticks with them long after they leave. Thank you for encouraging your students to take part in this opportunity.

Switching gears to ILC...

As a reminder, ILC registration requires more than just entering students into the CMS and submitting your invoice to finance.

To be considered fully registered, you must complete ALL components in the Oklahoma ILC Advisor Guide, including:

- Medical and Code of Conduct form submissions
- Pin pre-orders (optional; these can be invoiced and can also be purchased onsite with cash.)
- Volunteer sign-up selections
- Advisor contact information and hotel confirmations

Each of these pieces is essential. Registration is not complete without them.

Also, as previously communicated and noted on your invoice:

- All ILC payments are made out to Oklahoma HOSA
- Your SLC balance must be paid in full in order to ensure successful ILC registration

Please take a moment to review your accounts and confirm there are no outstanding balances.

Thank you for all that you do to make these opportunities possible for your students. The time, attention, and care you put into these details truly matter and they do not go unnoticed.
