We look forward to seeing you at registration on Sunday evening from 7:30–8:30 PM or Monday morning from 7:00–8:00 AM. As you finalize your preparations, here are a few important reminders to help everything run smoothly:

- **Student ID Requirement:**

All students must present a **proper photo ID** at competitive event check-in. Acceptable forms of ID can be found here:

- **Stop the Bleed Training:**

We currently have 73 students registered, but due to trainer capacity, only 50 students will be able to complete the certification training at this time.

We are actively working to secure additional trainers, but as it stands, this session is over capacity. Students beyond the first 50 registrants should consider themselves on a waitlist.

We still encourage all interested students to attend at the scheduled time. Inevitably, some registered participants may not show, and those open spots will be filled in order of original sign-up. I will do my best to communicate with advisors if this impacts your students—thank you in advance for your patience as we manage this high-interest opportunity.

- **Advisor Professional Development Session:**

Advisors attending the session for continuing education credit will scan a QR code at the end of the session to register for hours.

No pre-registration is required, and there is no cap on attendance. Certificates will be sent following the conference.

As we head into a conference of this size—over 3,600 attendees—let's remember to keep the main thing the main thing: **our students**. Stay positive and present. They will feed off of your energy. While not every student will walk away with a medal, every student can leave with new skills, confidence, and inspiration to grow as a future health professional.

Looking ahead, ILC room blocks for Oklahoma will open just three days after our conference concludes, so the turnaround will be quick.
