Subject: HOSA Happenings- 4/1/26- Important SLC Reminders

The countdown is ON! Just 5 days until we come together to celebrate 50 years of Oklahoma HOSA! I hope you are feeling prepared, excited, and ready for an incredible State Leadership Conference filled with connection, growth, and unforgettable moments.

As we head into the final stretch, here are a few important reminders to help everything run smoothly:

- First, it truly takes a village to raise a conference and we need ALL hands on deck. We still have openings for event managers, section leaders, and judges. Every advisor who is registered is expected to serve in some capacity. We cannot run competitive events without judges, and we currently still have events without coverage. All event personnel will check in at their assigned location at the judge registration table.

Everyone must sign in. Only event managers will pick up competitive event boxes. If you are assigned to Moore Norman, you may go directly there to check in, and your event boxes will also be returned at that site.

- This year, we are excited to attempt live streaming of general sessions so that parents and administrators can experience SLC in real time. Details on how to access the livestream will be shared through the conference app.
- To stay informed throughout the conference, advisors will need to download the Band App (green square with a white lowercase “b”). At registration, you will scan a QR code to be added. This platform is for advisors only. You will be responsible for communicating updates to your students. Downloading the app in advance will make the process much quicker onsite.
- A quick safety note- there will be latex balloons in the main ballroom and potentially other areas. Please ensure you have access to all student medical liability and code of conduct forms at all times.
- Also, please take a few minutes to review the Oklahoma GRRs. These guidelines include important details such as which events allow handshakes, which require flash drives for uploads, and other event-specific expectations.
- Finally, a BIG reminder- there is no free WiFi at the conference center. If you are judging, you will need a device and a plan for connectivity.

We are so close, and I cannot wait to celebrate this milestone year with each of you. Thank you for the role you play in making this experience meaningful for our students.
